What is e-Residency?

E-Residency is a **digital identity issued by the government of Estonia** to foreign nationals. After signing up, e-residents receive a starter kit containing a digital identity card that allows them to:



Establish an EU company 100% online



Access a wide range of **e-services** such as digital signatures, online business banking, and online tax filing



Remotely run a business from anywhere in the world with minimal bureaucracy

Why apply for Estonian e-Residency?

E-Residency is supported by the EU and governed by the Republic of Estonia, which also offers a world class business environment.

- Stable & trustworthy EU country with Nordic business culture
- #1 on the International Tax Competitiveness Index (2022) 0% corporate income tax on reinvested profits
- #1 Digital Economy and Society Index, EU Commission (2020) — a genuine digital society with 99% of public services online

Submit application

and pay relevant fees in the amount of €120



Application review

by the Estonian Police & Border Guard Board (approx. 3-8 weeks)



Pick up your e-Residency Starter Kit from one of the pick-up locations of

your choice



Launch your European company within a day
